LOT 2180

A late Victorian Neoclassical Revival satinwood display cabinet with overall foliate painted decoration, the arch moulded top above an astragal glazed door enclosing shelves, the base fitted with one drawer, raised on carved knob and reeded tapering legs united by an undertier, height 186cm, width 114cm, depth 44cm.

Estimate: £2,500 - £3,500

Condition Report

2180. Loss of blind fretwork to rounded corner of pediment. Also chips to the veneer on the front edge of the very top of the cabinet, above most people's eye-line. Small scuff to surface of left side frieze and some faults and chips to the feather plume mounts on the doors. There are some pieces of astragal moulding missing to the two side panels, where it appears to have had a horizontal bar and possibly an oval reserve. The door is not warped. There is a small surface chip to the left glass panel. Otherwise general appearance is quite good.
