### LOT 1221

A Chinese famille rose export porcelain punch bowl, Qianlong period, painted in the Mandarin palette with figural scenes against an iron red, black and gilt 'Y' diaper ground, height 11.5cm, diameter 28.4cm (cracked and repaired), together with a larger Chinese export porcelain punch bowl, Qianlong period, painted with panels of figures and animals, reserved against an iron red and gilt scroll ground, height 13.7cm, diameter 32.4cm (chipped and rivet repaired), and two carved hardwood stands (faults).

### Condition Report

1221. Large punch bowl - section of rim (10cm x 29cm) broken out and re-glued and 2cm x 1cm 'V' section missing from rim, and another chip to rim. 10cm hairline to rim. All cracks with rivet repairs. Typical wear to gilt and enamels.

Mandarin palette punch bowl - 9cm x 14cm section of rim broken out and re-glued. 10cm hairline to rim and a 8cm hairline to rim. Typical light wear to enamels and gilt.

Smaller wood stand - small section of apron broken and missing otherwise stand in generally good order.

Larger stand - generally good condition.
