A silver and pastel shaded enamel necklace, circa 1930s, decorated with palmette and scrolling motifs, detailed 'Silver', probably by Bernard Instone, length 42.5cm, and a sterling silver and vari-coloured enamelled brooch, designed as a butterfly, width 5.3cm.

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### Condition Report

677. Butterfly - chips to edges of enamel wings. Pin slightly misshapen but otherwise ok.

Chain - good condition. Enamel with no chips, cracks or repairs. Please note, each end has two extra links, each with a pierced centre. Presumably later added to increase the length. They have been well matched.

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
