A pair of Chinese famille rose export porcelain plates, Yongzheng/Qianlong period, each centre painted with a pavilion and fenced garden containing tables laden with precious vessels, red capped crane, flowers, rocks and lingzhi, within a rim of precious objects and flowers, diameter 22.8cm (hairlines and minor rim chips), together with another export plate, Qianlong period, painted with scattered flowers, diameter 23cm (minor rim fritting).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1232. Floral plate - good condition, typical fritting/minor chips to glaze on rim. Otherwise OK.

Pair - both with star cracks to centre of base, one with rim chip, otherwise in good order with no other cracks, chips or repairs. Typical light surface wear to enamels and gilt.
