Condition Report

69. Previously cleaned and restored. UV examination highlights some overpainting throughout, but particularly to the sky and details in the foreground. This has been undertaken quite sympathetically. Paint a little 'thin' in areas. Gilt frame repainted 'gilt' and repaired, quite crudely in places. Composition looks a little unstable and some subsequent scuffs and scratches are present.
