A single series opaque twist stem wine glass, circa 1770, the ogee bowl moulded with flutes above the centrally knopped stem with multiple spiral opaque twists above a folded foot, height 15.3cm, together with three 18th century airtwist stem wine glasses (each with chipped foot).

Condition Report

1707. Ogee bowled glass - chip to underside of foot and manufacturing flaw to footrim.

Other three glasses - all have a number of chips to the underside of the footrim, a couple quite wide in appearance.
