A Staffordshire pearlware tureen and cover in the form of a dove, early 19th century, the base modelled in the form of a nest with shredded clay details, iron red painted '57' to base, length 16.5cm (restored), together with a pearlware figure of Hotei, early 19th century, modelled seated in black robes, height 11cm (faults and restoration).

### Condition Report

1512. The dove looks to have been broken in half across the shoulder area and professionally restored and overpainted. There are a couple of minor chips to tail of bird, but nothing significant. The base is in generally good condition with no cracks or repairs. Small chip to rim and very minor chips to moss relief decoration.
