## Condition Report

2235. General appearance is ok, however the top has some overall light scratches and a few slightly deeper scratches. One of the legs is missing one side of bead and reel moulding and there are a few other small areas of damage to the frieze mouldings. It would probably benefit from a set of castors to bring the height up slightly. Winding mechanism working fine.
