A Breitling gilt metal fronted and steel backed gentleman's chronograph wristwatch, circa 1950s, Ref. No. 1192, with signed jewelled movement, the signed silver 'bow tie' dial with gilt hour markers and two subsidiary dials, the case back detailed 'Breitling, Stainless Steel Back' and numbered '1192', case diameter 4cm, on a black leather strap.

Estimate: £500 - £700

Condition Report

1045. Generally good clean condition, no significant damage or repairs. Not currently working. Adjusts smoothly and button functions, all work as they should but does not quite return to 12 o'clock. Dial looks clean but under closer inspection there are some small scratches, particularly around the right hand side subsidiary dial. Lettering and markings all clear. Case in good order with typical light wear and scratches. Strap not original and not a box or papers.

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
