An 18ct gold cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's chronograph pocket watch, the gilt jewelled lever movement detailed 'Evershed 121 Church Road, West Brighton No 8489', the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, outer black Arabic minute numerals, blued steel hands and centre seconds, the case back interior numbered '8489', London 1888, case diameter 5.1cm, with a brass travelling case and a base metal Brazil link chain.
