LOT 1601

A Loetz lemonade jug and two beakers, early 20th century, designed by Richard Teschner, the milky jug of zoomorphic form with applied features, the matching beakers with green teardrop decoration, indistinct acid etched mark to jug, height of jug 18cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1601. Jug - in good condition overall with no chips, cracks or repairs. The two small teardrops to either side of the body have slightly flawed/rough tails and the tip of one side of the applied green 'moustache' has a small adhesion, but these are all manufacturing issues.

1st glass - small chip to rim and tiny losses to tails of teardrops.

2nd glass - small chip to inner rim edge and some incredibly indistinct nicks to rim. 2 applied teardrops with minor losses to tail ends. Small white noticeable inclusion to side wall of glass, a manufacturing issue.
