Condition Report

2008. The leather has a general overall wear and some more extensive wear to the curved area of the seat, including some splits. The mahogany frame is in good order with some minor scuffs and scratches. The brass hinge system is a bit loose but just needs some screws tightening. The carpet-covered footrest is quite worn.
