A bobbin stem wine glass, early 19th century, the rounded funnel bowl raised on a three-bobbin stem and conical foot, height 20.5cm, together with a mixed group of Georgian and Victorian glasses and a Continental glass, engraved with a coat of arms and a Masonic emblem, height 19cm.

Condition Report

1602. Bobbin - there are a couple of tiny nibbles to the foot rim, more noticeable when felt rather than obvious without magnification, otherwise in good condition.

Coat of Arms - there are the tiniest of nibbles to the facet edges on the stem, these are only noticeable under magnification otherwise in good condition.
