## LOT 1145

A Regency mahogany bracket clock with eight day movement striking hours on a bell with pull repeat mechanism, the painted circular dial with black Roman numerals and inscribed 'Wm. Goodhugh London', the brass-inlaid case with brass pineapple finial above brass drop handles and pierced scale fret panels to the side and recessed corner panels to the front, on a plinth base and brass ball feet, height 49cm, with pendulum and a brass-inlaid mahogany wall bracket.

## Condition Report

1145. Good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs.

Movement looks to be original and appears to be in generally good clean order and is currently working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Dial has typical light crazing and some minor wear.

Case is generally good with some minor splitting to veneer either side of the dial. Metalwork is slightly tarnished in places, but overall in good order. Case key present, but no winder. Bracket tin good condition, typical minor knocks and minor scuffs.

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
