LOT 2601

An Edwardian brass floor standing oil lamp with floral swag and flowerhead mounts, height 130cm, together with a wrought iron and copper mounted oil lamp (both converted to electricity).

Estimate: £30 - £50

Condition Report

2601. The Edwardian brass lamp has a good quality sturdy base with only minor surface wear typical for its age. The stem has a small patch of resin filler that presumably fills a hole previously made for electrical wire. The oil reservoir has a few dents to the top and a slightly crude light bulb fitting. I would suggest both lamps would need re-wiring.

The wrought iron lamp has some overall light surface rust and some tarnish to the copper mounts, but seems to be sturdy enough. Again, the bulb mount is a bit crude and may need re-fitting.
