A pair of late 18th/early 19th century Continental carved ivory figures of standing cherubs, finely modelled holding small baskets of grapes on their shoulders, one mounted on a turned circular base, heights 18cm and 16.5cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2515. One cherub has slight loss to the edge of one wing, a tiny chip to one vine leaf and a small chip to edge of base. Otherwise some minor hairline surface cracks and some glue residue to edge of base. The cherub with the extra base has loss to the bottom edges of both wings, a few minor chips to the grapes and leaves, also one hairline crack to buttock. Total weight of both cherubs = 588g.
