A Lalique clear and frosted glass square pot and cover for 'La Jacée', House of Coty, France, early 20th century, the cover decorated in relief with stylized trees, moulded 'Coty France' to base, height 5.6cm, together with nine perfume bottles and stoppers, including a Baccarat for Guerlain example and two with silver mounts.

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1608. Coty France box - couple of small chips to underside of lid.

Green tinted perfume - portion missing to end of stopper, a few small chips to high points also.

Vielle France bottle - couple of small nibbles to stopper and rim of bottle.

Bottle with faceted circular stopper - a few chips to end of stopper.

Smaller 'Chant D'aromes' bottle - some clouding to interior.

Baccarat example - the paper label is quite worn, large chip to end of stopper, the missing portion is wedged within the neck of the bottle.

Others in generally good condition.
