A pair of Chinese famille rose porcelain vases, mid-19th century, each shouldered body and flared neck painted with opposing figural scenes, reserved against a ground of flowers and birds, the neck applied with turquoise glazed Buddhist lion and cub handles above moulded chilong to shoulders, height 35cm.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

1160. Both vases in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Few very minor chips to rims but no cracks. One has a slightly matt glaze to its foot but not significant. Good vibrant colours. Minor wear to enamels and gilt.
