A collection of South-east Asian metalwork and works of art, 19th century and later, including a Japanese bronze and cloisonné figure of Kannon, height 19.8cm, a Tibetan copper and brass cylindrical jar and cover, height 18cm, a Chinese gilt bronze dragon bangle, width 8cm, and a bone mounted dome top trunk with hinged lid, length 36cm.

Condition Report

1275. Japanese cloisonne and bronze Kannon - some pitting and minor losses to the enamel, typical surface wear but otherwise in good order.

Giltwood seated Buddha - missing one left arm and missing attributes which would have been held in two hands. Some chips and wear to the later painted gilt finish.
