A Chinese sang-de-boeuf glazed porcelain vase, Qing dynasty, of baluster form with flared neck, height 36.5cm (drilled hole to base).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1114. 5cm hairline crack to rim, otherwise body is in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. However, there is a hole in the base with chipped out missing sections that can be seen in the photographs. There is also a crack running either side of this damage, one 4cm in length, the other is 11cm long and runs over the foot and into the lower section of the vase.
