A Chinese famille rose export porcelain saucer, late Qianlong period, painted with alternating figural and floral panels within ropetwist and lattice borders, diameter 13.5cm, together with a pair of famille rose export porcelain tea bowls and matching saucer, painted with flowers (one tea bowl cracked, the other with rim chip), and a Samson famille rose export style plate.

Estimate: £40 - £60

1112. Figural saucer - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Two tea bowls - one with hairline crack, one with minor rim chip. Otherwise in good order.

Matching saucer - good condition. No chips, cracks or repairs.

Plate - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
