A George III 1788 pattern light cavalry sword with straight single-edged fullered blade, blade length 79.5cm, shaped stirrup guard, wire-bound grip, with steel scabbard, together with a Victorian 1822 pattern infantry officer's sword and scabbard.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1801. 1788 Sword - overall untouched condition, evidence throughout of rust and pitting. Fatigue and holes forming to scabbard tip. 1 ring suspension lacking, some shrinkage to grip. Impact marks to scabbard.

1822 Pattern sword - Overall very poor condition throughout. Fatigue and wear, grip shows signs of breaking down and discoloration, blade rusting, leather scabbard has some splitting, steel repair to end of scabbard, blade tip missing, guard misshapen.
