A first pattern Fairbairn Sykes fighting knife with straight double-edged blade, blade length 17cm, detailed 'The F-S Fighting Knife, Wilkinson Sword, London', S-shaped nickel plated guard, chequered grip, with nickel-mounted brown leather sheath.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1811. Blade shows evidence of light rust being removed with wire wool, light scratching. Guard and handle untouched, pommel nut has some dents and light marks probably vice marks. Some staining to grip area. Blade tip misshapen ever so slightly. Nickel mountings on sheath losing plating in areas. Some fatigue and splitting to leather work at top.
