A George I walnut chest-on-stand, the moulded top above two short and three long drawers, the base fitted with four further drawers, on shaped supports, height 148cm, width 105cm, depth 60cm (alterations and lacking legs).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

2016. General condition is quite poor, as can be seen through illustrations. Apart from some small veneer repairs around drawers and bases of feet, the overall veneered surfaces are original. There is a replaced strip of veneer just under the top moulding of the pediment and some loss to the veneer around the whole pediment. The handles have been replaced numerous times leaving filled holes on the drawer fronts. Key escutcheons are also replaced leaving shadows of older plates.

Some overall areas of damage to drawer beading and sides. Clearly lacking its legs and it has had replaned mouldings around central join.
