A Chinese hardwood domed cover/lid, late Qing dynasty, carved and pierced in the form of lotus leaves, diameter 15.5cm, together with three other Chinese carved and pierced hardwood circular covers, diameters 12.5cm, 12.5cm and 13.8cm, and two Chinese carved and pierced hardwood stands, diameters of tops 10.2cm and 13cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

1025. Cover carved with lotus leaves - missing stalk finial, chips to edges and a reglued split, only really noticeable to underside.

Pierced lid with finial - good condition no damage or repairs.

Pierced dome lid - good condition no damage or repairs.

Other pierced lid - good condition no significant damage or repairs. Few tiny nicks.

Low stand - good condition

Taller stand - good condition, no significant damage but a few of the joints have been reglued.
