A large Victorian gilt-tooled red leather governmental dispatch box, the hinged lid with central Royal coat of arms flanked by crowned 'V.R.' cyphers, all four sides similarly tooled with crowned 'V.R.' cyphers, all within a foliate border, the sides fitted with gilt bronze drop handles, the green leather-lined interior revealing the lock plate, inscribed 'S. Mordan & Co', height 26.5cm, width 53.5cm, depth 36cm.

Condition Report

2581. For a box of this age and use the condition is reasonable. There is overall surface wear and loss of leather to the corners. There is a minor surface crack across the leather on the top, some areas of loose leather and overall scuffs and bumps. Most of this should be clearly seen from the photos.
