A large majolica jardinière of Minton type, late 19th century, the tapered cylindrical body decorated with three dragon panels within ochre glazed borders against a turquoise ground, raised on three claw and ball feet, turquoise glazed interior, unmarked, height 44cm (faults and restoration).

Condition Report

1444. Heavily crazed overall with significant glaze loss to interior sides and associated cracks to body - notably the base interior and sides, visible to the exterior and interior. Visibly restored approximately 12cm long repair to rim and 2 similar larger restored areas to base underside with some glaze loss here too.
