A Chinese blue and white porcelain bottle vase, Kangxi period, the globular body with flared narrow neck, painted with foliate panels within scroll borders, height 17.5cm (restored), and another Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, Transitional period, mid-17th century, of shouldered tapering form, painted with birds perched in blossoming branches, height 20cm (cracked and restored).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1023. Bottle vase - two areas of restoration to the rim and the footrim has also been restored. The overpainting has 'yellowed' over time. The rest of the vase is in good order.

Transitional vase - approximately half of the rim and neck have been restored and the overpainting has 'yellowed' over time. Also a 9cm diagonal crack to the body as show in images.
