A late 19th/early 20th century French oak extending dining table, the rectangular moulded top with two later-made oak leaves, the frieze carved with masks, raised on turned and reeded legs united by a shaped stretcher, height 75cm, extended length 254cm, depth 100cm.

## Condition Report

2044. The top, including the two solid oak later made leaves, is in good order, with one minor area of gapping where the timber was originally joined on one end. Otherwise minor surface scratching and some fairly substantial surface wear to the masks and edges of the frieze and legs.
