A Chinese blue and white porcelain bowl, late 19th century, painted with dragons chasing flaming pearls, underglaze blue four-character mark to base, diameter 22.9cm (hairline cracks to rim), together with a collection of other Chinese porcelain, 19th century and later, including a Canton famille rose vase, height 32.5cm, and a seated figure of a monkey god, height 17cm (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1032. Blue and white dragon bowl - two 7cm hairlines to rim otherwise no chips or repairs.

3 x side plates - good condition with no chips, crackles or repairs.

Crackle glazed vase - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Slight staining/discoloration to glaze.

Blue and white mug - 8cm crack to rim and handle broken off and reglued. A few chips to rim and footrim.

Blue and white vase - damaged rim and neck otherwise ok.

Pottery figure - chip to left ear. Figure has been broken in half across the shoulders and repaired. Minor chip to base.
