### LOT 1012

A Chinese red Peking glass snuff bottle, late Qing dynasty, of flattened pear form with moulded ring handles, height 6.2cm (chip to rim), together with a group of Chinese hardstone carvings, including a bat pendant, a flower vase pendant, a carved coral dog and a plated child's rattle, modelled as two children, united by a chain.

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

1012. Red glass snuff bottle - lacking stopper/cover, flat chip to rim covering approx one third of area, flattened sides quite heavily scratched.

Bat pendant - good condition.

Vase pendant - good condition.

Coral dog - minute nick to base edge.

Rattle - small splits to figures.

Single earring - good condition.

Jade ring - good condition.

Bead - some losses.

Jade cigarette holder - some natural inclusions but in good condition overall.
