A small group of Chinese blue and white export porcelain, Kangxi period and later, comprising a teapot and cover, three coffee cups and a saucer (some faults), together with a Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, late 19th century, of baluster form, height 15.5cm (minor chips).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1102. Small vase - generally good but glaze fritting/minor chips around foot.

Teapot - pot in good condition, cover has a chip to rim, restoration to rim and wear to gilt.

Saucer - repaired section of rim (9cm x 4cm).

Floral Kangxi cup - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Figural Kangxi cup - repaired handle, otherwise ok.

Export cup - good condition.
