Condition Report

1054. Vase 1 - small bruise near base of vase, not obviously noticeable, otherwise good condition.

Vase 2 - small bruise to middle of body, but again only really noticeable on close inspection.

Otherwise they are in good condition. Wear to gilding on copper mounts.
