A Wedgwood blue lustre octagonal bowl, 1920s, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, gilt with dragons and Oriental motifs, gilt printed Portland Vase mark and painted pattern No. Z4829 to base, diameter 20cm, together with a Crown Devon Fieldings blue lustre circular fruit bowl, gilt with butterflies, diameter 30cm.

Condition Report

1406. Wedgwood bowl - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or restoration. The gilding and enamels are still bright and strong with no real wear. The interior detail is blurry (a manufacturing issue), with wear only to gilding on base interior. Some typical minor scratches to exterior.

Crown Devon Bowl - heavily crazed overall, but not visible beneath decoration. Gilding typically rubbed mainly to rims and interior. Crack to rim.
