LOT 4167

A rare Bernard Moore lime green glazed monkey group, early 20th century, modelled as five seated monkeys fighting over a fruit, each with applied glass eyes, indistinct impressed mark to base, height 6.3cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

4167. The two monkeys to the left of the main monkey have haircracks and a firing crack around the limbs and base where they join to the main monkey - these are really only noticeable on close inspection, i.e. haircrack visible by the join to the underside, the small slice chip by the haircrack to one of the smaller monkey's hands when viewed directly above, and the firing crack to the monkey's wrist when viewed from the front.

Otherwise two pinhead sized spots of glaze loss to one monkey's ear and neck.

No restoration.
