An Edmund Elton Sunflower Pottery jug, 1879-1930, the tapered ovoid body relief decorated with two blue flowers on a brown stem against a streaked blue, green and purple ground, painted mark to base, height 16.5cm, together with an Ault pottery jug, probably designed by Christopher Dresser, painted with flowers against a shaded blue ground, the interior yellow glazed, impressed numerals '177' to base, height 18cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

4177. Elton jug - typical overall fine crazing to glaze. Some very minor spots of glaze loss/blemishes, primarily to raised detail. Small flat chip to one raised leaf, approx 5mm x 3mm.

Ault jug - typical overall fine crazing to glaze. Haircrack to rim edge of spout above a firing crack, approx 3cm long. Otherwise ok.
