A Linthorpe pottery vase, late 19th century, designed by Christopher Dresser, the dimpled body beneath an extended cylindrical neck, covered in a running blue glaze over a yellow ground, impressed mark to base with shape number '24', height 23cm.

### Condition Report

4131. Typical overall fine crazing to glaze. Two tiny pinhead sized spots of glaze loss to neck rim exterior. Glaze overall has a significant number of deep scratches and scuff marks/bruises. A number of glazed-over firing cracks visible to base underside.
