33. The board has bowed somewhat. Heavy craquelure throughout resulting in considerable paint loss to clowns and background. This may be a result of extreme heat. It is recorded that Lowndes had a fire at his studio and many circus scenes were lost. Relatively clean. Frame with minor scuffs and scratches.
