## LOT 58

Attributed to William Buelow Gould - Still Life with Hare, Snipe, Pheasant and a Basket of Eggs, 19th century oil on canvas, 59cm x 49cm, within a gilt composition frame. Note: Gould was transported to Tasmania, Australia as a convict for petty theft in 1827. He is now regarded as one of the most important early artists of the colony.

## Condition Report

58. Some heavy craquelure throughout, however appears stable. Canvas slack on stretcher and as a result stretcher lines are showing through in places. Varnish is uneven and blooming/dulling inconsistently. Varnish has also yellowed. Some minor surface dirt. Frame has been crudely repaired and repainted 'gilt'. There is also some subsequent damage to the frame.
