An 18ct gold, sapphire and diamond cluster ring, claw set with the circular cut sapphire within a surround of circular cut diamonds, London 1962, ring size approx Q1/2.

Estimate: £140 - £160

Condition Report

507. The sapphire is an inky blue/black colour showing some wear to the facet edges and there is one slightly larger nick. The surrounding diamonds are eight cut stones, they are fairly clear but some have one or two inclusions. The ring is showing signs of wear at the sides where it has been worn up against other rings and some claws are starting to show signs of wear particularly to the diamonds. There is evidence of a crack to the shank which is starting to appear. The hallmark is clear and readable, but there is no apparent makers mark. There is no inscription. The ring does not look to have been resized in the past. Weight 4.6g.

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
