A European gold and rose cut diamond brooch, circa 1900, in a pierced quatrefoil openwork design with a rose cut diamond nine stone cluster to the centre, width 3.4cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

510. There is some variation of cut to the rose diamonds. Some of the rose diamonds have a few piqué and gletz inclusions. There is evidence of re-soldered restoration to the centre of the brooch below the principal cluster. One connecting pin at the back of the principal cluster is missing, however the principal cluster is now soldered into position. Weight 6.6g.
