A silver mounted vari-coloured agate bracelet, probably Scottish, second half of the 19th century, formed as a row of six faceted baton shaped links, with a cornelian set heart shaped clasp with scroll engraved decoration, length 19cm.

Condition Report

563. Some of the edge caps to the agate links may have been re-glued in the past. The cap to the banded agate link next to the clasp is starting to come away but appears to be reasonably secure at the moment. There is no mark to the clasp and the clasp is in good condition. The connecting links to the agate batons are starting to open up and it would be advisable to have these professionally closed up and soldered.
