A platinum and diamond cluster ring, claw set with the principal cushion shaped diamond within a surround of ten smaller cushion shaped diamonds, detailed 'Platinum', ring size approx K.

Condition Report

668. The principal diamond looks to be a fairly clear stone, slight florescence. The claws to the principal diamond are worn in places and require attention. There is some variation of cut to the surrounding diamonds and evidence of wear to the edges of the surrounding diamonds. Gross weight of ring 2.8grams. The ring has been sized in the past. Suggested age ♦ 1920s. There are possible traces of lead solder to one shoulder. Weight 2.9g.

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
