An 18ct gold, ruby and diamond cluster ring, mounted with four cushion shaped rubies within a surround of cushion shaped diamonds, Birmingham 1966, ring size approx L, and a gold and diamond single stone ring, mounted with a circular cut diamond, detailed '18ct', ring size approx K1/2.

Condition Report

680. Ruby and diamond cluster ♦ there is slight variation of colour saturation to the rubies. There is slight surface wear to the facet edges of the rubies. The diamonds slightly draw colour. The surrounding diamonds are eight cut diamonds. Some diamonds have a few surface reaching inclusions. The claws particularly to the diamonds are starting to show signs of wear. The ring has a sprung sizing clip within the shank. Gross weight of the ring is approx 3.8grams. The ring would benefit from careful professional cleaning. Weight 3.9g.
Diamond single stone ♦ the diamond has one or two piqu♦ inclusions. The ring would benefit from careful professional cleaning. The diamond weight approximately 0.23ct. Gross weight of the ring is approx 1.6grams. The ring has considerable wear either side of the ring where it has been rubbing up against other rings on either side. Weight 1.7g.
