## Condition Report

2009. The stained pine and oak plate rack is probably a marriage with the base and has had some later sections fitted to it. There are some chips to the edges of the pot shelf and some shrinkage, so the front edge has a small gap between the front fascia of the base. Some fairly typical scuffs and a few small cracks and chips to the edges of the top.
