An Edwardian Arts and Crafts oak framed armchair, designed by G.M. Ellwood for J.S. Henry, upholstered in a foliate patterned damask, the winged sides and front seat rail carved in relief with acorn and oak leaf roundels, the shaped armrests on downswept supports, raised on block legs united by stretchers, height 115cm, width 69cm, depth 67cm.

## Condition Report

4035. Both rear legs are walnut, as per lot 4034, and the bottom caps on the legs appear to be later replaced. The rear stretcher is also possibly a later replacement. Otherwise condition of frame is ok and the upholstery has a light stain to the seat pad.
