A Liberty & Co 'Tudric' pewter mantel timepiece, model number '0557', the circular copper dial with a central blue/green enameled reserve within engraved Roman numerals, the shaped case cast with stylized honesty, the Lenzkirch movement numbered '522762', the underside of the case bearing stamped model number, height 19cm (lacking hands).

Condition Report

4083. The dial is currently detached and has a misshapen edge between 5 and 7 o'clock, otherwise some loss to the black detailing. The movement doesn't seem to be in working order, as it appears that it has been overwound. The case is in reasonable condition with overall tarnishing and minor surface scuffs and scratches. There is one small dent to left side, the left side dial surround has been slightly pushed back and there are other small bumps to extremities. Please also note there are no hands.

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
