An A.J. Wilkinson Ltd United Services style pottery cruet set, 1930s, with banded polychrome decoration, comprising salt, pepper and mustard, together with an A.J. Wilkinson Ltd hippo ashtray, designed by Clarice Cliff, and a bird napkin ring, probably Carlton Ware.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1534. Napkin ring - a couple of chips to the paintwork on head and circular aperture. Otherwise ok with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Hippo - in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Cruet set - salt cork has broken and the stopper no longer secures to the body, also with some minor crazing. Rest of items with a couple of very minor surface scratches to the polychrome bands, but fundamentally in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.
