A large pair of Meissen porcelain fruit and flower encrusted vases, 19th century, the basketweave moulded white glazed baluster bodies with gilded line detail, applied in high relief overall with fruits and flowers, underglaze blue crossed swords mark to bases, height 36cm (some faults and losses). Note: a similar pair sold at Bonhams Los Angeles, 7-8 December 2015, Lot 1574.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,000

Condition Report

1500. Vase 1 - two chips to the footrim, minor wear to gilding. Some general losses to the encrusted flowers/leaves overall, heavy losses in places, otherwise ok with no chips, cracks or restoration.

Vase 2 - some general losses to the encrusted flowers/leaves overall, heavy in places, one whole flower on neck missing. Otherwise ok with no cracks, chips or repairs. Minor wear to gilding.
