12 Knives - 1 handle split, other handles ok. Typical light wear to silver, typical rubbing to marks. Two blades with damage and mishaping.

12 Forks - 1 handle split, other handles ok. Typical light wear to silver. Typical light rubbing to marks. Slight mishaping to tines.

Case is loose at joints and lock is broken.
